

HORIZON EUROPE CLUSTER 5 REGIONAL INFO DAY ENHANCING EU-CENTRAL ASIA RESEARCH COLLABORATION IN HORIZON EUROPE 20 May 2025 Almaty, Kazakhstan

Background

Horizon Europe is the European Union's flagship research and innovation program with an ambitious budget of 95.5 billion Euros. One of the key advantages of Horizon Europe is its comprehensive approach, fostering collaborations across various sectors and disciplines.

Since May 2024, with support from the EU funded project SECCA, several Horizon Europe national and regional informational events have been conducted with a specific focus on Cluster 5 (climate, energy and mobility) in Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan and Turkmenistan. The workshop *Horizon Europe in Central Asia – Promoting Research Excellence and Collaboration for Sustainable Energy*, held in Astana on 14th May 2024, marked a significant step in raising awareness about the program in Kazakhstan. At that time, the level of awareness about the program was generally low and the National Contact Points (NCP) were limited to Kazakhstan and Kyrgyzstan, without any NCP designated for Cluster 5.

In less than a year, through various project activities, **NCP networks** were established by the national authorities in two additional countries—Uzbekistan and Turkmenistan, while **NCPs for Cluster 5** were nominated in Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan and Uzbekistan. This clearly demonstrates will and commitment in the above-mentioned countries to enhance R&I cooperation with EU under Horizon Europe program.

To assist organizations in finding EU partners for Horizon Europe projects, a **cooperation profile template** was developed by SECCA in collaboration with the Science Fund of Kazakhstan. Following this, 21 organizations from Kazakhstan as well as 13 institutions from Uzbekistan, completed the templates focusing on topics related to Cluster 5. A similar activity is currently ongoing in Turkmenistan and Kyrgyzstan.

To further assist these organizations and guide them toward building successful partnerships within the program, a regional Info Day is organized. This event aims to provide participants with practical guidance on partner searches and foster new opportunities for networking and collaboration, both regionally and internationally.

The Info Day targets research institutions and universities from Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Uzbekistan and Turkmenistan, especially those that have completed the cooperation profile template, as they move toward active participation in Horizon Europe. Therefore, the speakers and topics are designed to focus primarily on **practical information, such as partner search and the use of the National Contact Points network** both **nationally and regionally**, assuming that participants already have basic knowledge of the program and its participation rules.

<u>Target audience for advanced regional workshop:</u> Research institutions and universities that filled the cooperation offer template in Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Uzbekistan and Turkmenistan.
